## Conditions of Play:

- The Championship is open to members of Aberdeenshire, Angus, Northern Counties and Perth and Kinross County Golf Associations. The winner will hold the title "North of Scotland Champion" and will retain the Gifford Trophy for one year. The Winner of the Handicap Section will retain the Angus Trophy for one year.
- 2. Competitors must hold a 'c' status CONGU ® handicap. The Committee reserve the right to limit entry by handicap if necessary. CDH numbers must be provided.
- 3. There will be one qualifying round on Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2017.
- 4. The sixteen best scratch and best handicap scores qualify for match play. In the event of a tie, the count-out formula will be applied. The count-out formula will comprise the lowest last 9, 6, 3 or 1 hole of the qualifying round.
- 5. There will be an automatic draw for match play.
- First and second match play rounds on Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> July and semi-final and final rounds on Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> July. In the event of a tie, competitors shall play until one or other gains a hole.
- 7. Prizes will be awarded to the winner, runner up and semi-finalists in each section. The prizes in the qualifying round will be decided according to entry. (Scratch will take precedence in deciding prize-winners).
- 8. There will be a consolation stroke play round for non-qualifiers on Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> July.
- 9. The committee's decision will be final.
